

Dade City Rod and Gun Club Meeting 1-8-19

Attendance- There were 8 Board Members present. There were also 11 members present.

Secretary's Report- Sandi reviewed the minutes of the December meeting. Motion to accept the Secretaries report by Roger Smith and 2nd by Warren Magill – motion approved.

Treasurer's Report- Chet confirmed with all Board members that they received the December treasurers report. Discussion about the yearly P&L Comparison between 2017/2018. The major factors that caused the difference in 2018 were the insurance costs and building and grounds improvements. CD's will be purchased in January and will "laddered" so that after the first year we will have a CD that matures every year.

The DCRGC Corporation is a registered Florida "Not for Profit Corporation". The state where the organization is incorporated will set out the rules and requirements for establishing a corporation. However, a not-for-profit corporation is distinctive in two ways: first, the corporation cannot be organized for any person's private gain; second, should it dissolve, the company must distribute its assets to a similar tax-exempt non-profit group. There are no restrictions or requirements to how much money is in the bank as long as it is not used for private gain.

CSRO Report – There were no major incidents to report last month. There was a total of 950 shooters, 330 nonmembers, 26 guests, 56 juniors, 22 new members and 24 renewals. The CSRO is asking for all RSOs to fill out an info card and drop it in the RSO box in the office. Motion to accept the CSRO report by Jerry Grady and 2nd by Warren Magill – motion approved.

Building and Grounds Report- Routine maintenance continued at the club. New LED lights have been placed on all the Rifle lanes on the Public range. More sand has been placed on the 100-yard range berm. There was more routine maintenance on the bullet catcher. The tractor will be taken in for its yearly maintenance. Spectrum will be in later this week to finish wiring up the clubhouse for Internet and phone services. TECO came out and fixed the pole light at the entrance to the club. The Lead crew will be back out on the 17th for more lead removal. Motion to accept the Building and Grounds report by Bill Johnson and 2nd by Warren Magill – motion approved.

Old Business- The club will be hosting another Member BBQ on February 16th. Emails will be sent for RSVPs. Motion to accept the Old Business by Roger Smith and 2nd by Warren Magill – motion approved.

New Business- Jean Nathe from Friends of the NRA did a small presentation explaining grants that the club could use for training and Range Improvements. More info on this to follow.
