

LEO Qualifier Match
2nd Saturday of Each Month
After the Silhouette Match
(At this time, there is no fee to shoot this match)

The LEO Qualifier match is the standard that most Law Enforcement agencies in Florida require their Officers to pass for certification. Most Law Enforcement agencies require 12 round magazines for their officers primary carry firearm. We have modified the match in order to accommodate shooters with firearms that have less than 12 rounds capacity. The match uses 40 rounds and is scored by counting the misses. You must not have more than 8 misses to qualify.

Equipment: Center fire Revolver or Semi-Auto Pistol with open sights. Side Carry Holster Only - **NO** Back, Crossdraw or Shoulder rigs permitted. All firearms must rest in a holster designed for that particular type firearm. Revolver shooters must have 3 speed loaders with six round capacity. Semi-Auto shooters must have 3 magazines with six round capacity. Targets: B-34 size target will be used.
