If all runs smoothly for those days then the ranges will open for a full schedule starting Monday June 1. **The club will be closed Thursdays for maintenance.**

No eye or ear protection will be provided and access to the clubhouse will be limited to the rest rooms. Shooters are asked to use a face covering and maintain six foot distancing.
