

# RANGE ALERTS

## Please read these Alerts before coming to the range!

1. The Board of Directors (BOD) voted to comply with Pasco County Order to wear a face covering whenever the six foot social distance can not be kept.
2. Steel or armor piercing, tracer, incendiary or any other explosive or fire-based rounds ARE NOT allowed to be fired on any of the ranges.
3. The Range Dress/Behavior Code is directed due to its importance to SAFETY.
  - 3.1. No Low Cut Collars; brass is very hot and is capable of going into any opening.
  - 3.2. Closed Toe Shoes Only - NO sandals or flip-flops.
  - 3.3. Hats Are Suggested But NOT Required.
  - 3.4. No Profanity; children may be present.
4. Junior (Anyone who has not reached their eighteenth (18) birthday) shoot for free and must be accompanied by and directly supervised by a paying adult/Member.
  - 4.1. Non-member paying adults are limited to two (2) juniors under their supervision.
  - 4.2. Juniors are not assigned a shooting position and in compliance with Florida State Statute, 790.22, must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult.
  - 4.3. At the discretion of the on-duty RSO, JUNIORS MUST SHOW PROOF OF AGE - Please bring proper identification.
5. The minimum age to shoot at the DCGC is 8 years old.
  - 5.1. Prior to their 13th birthday, Juniors may not shoot pistols of any caliber. Juniors are limited to rimfire rifles only, any action type EXCEPT SEMI-AUTOMATIC.
  - 5.2 From ages 13 to those who have not yet reached their 18th birthday (Juniors) may shoot any firearm allowed on the range.
  - 5.4. All Junior shooters must be accompanied by, and directly supervised by, a paid adult shooter or member. Direct supervision means sitting/physically at the firing position bench with direct physical access to the Junior.
  - 5.5. Exemptions to the above caliber restrictions, age, or firearm type may be issued by qualified DCGC NRA Instructors only. Contacts for issuance of Exemptions are: Bill Johnson (352-834-4080) and Dennis Doll (813-963-7396).
6. Service Animals are allowed on the Range if outfitted with **proper eye and ear protection (owner provided)**. Owner must maintain control of the animal at ALL times.
